Directions:

From Asheville NC: drive from Asheville to 632 Manor Road in Mars Hill, NC, head north on I-26. The approximately 20-mile trip takes about 25 minutes depending on traffic. From downtown Asheville, merge onto I-26 W / US-19 N / US-23 N. Follow I-26 W for about 16.5 miles. Take Exit 11 for NC-213 W toward Mars Hill/Marshall. Turn left onto NC-213 W (also known as Carl Eller Rd / Main St) and continue for about 1.5 miles. Turn onto Manor Road to reach your destination.

From TN: Get on I-26 E / US-23 S from Upper Higgins Creek Road. Follow I-26 E / US-23 S across the state line into Madison County, North Carolina. Take Exit 9 to leave the highway. Take a right on Crossroads Parkway to Manor Road to arrive at The Ranger District Office at Appalachian District Office and Work-Center Building 632 Manor Road Mars Hill, NC 28754.
